- So you may have fellowship with us, and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son, Jesus Christ 1:3


- Because John said, “Let what you heard from the beginning abide in you. 2: 24 (You will be abiding (walking with) the Son and abiding in the Father. Hiding God’s Word in your heart is abiding in Him.)
- It helps you overcome those who try to deceive you. I John 2:26 so you may overcome the world with our faith Who overcomes the world except for the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?
- So that we may know him who is true, and we are in him who is true, in His Son Jesus

Christ. He is the true God and eternal life.

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*“And you were dead in the trespasses and sins in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of dis-obedience — among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. BUT God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our tres-passes, made us alive together with Christ — by grace you have been saved — and raised us up with Him in heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the coming ages He might show the immeasurable riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing, it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.” Ephesian 2: 1-9 (ESV).*

You see, if your spirit (the part of you that can worship God), is not made alive by God Himself, then these verses will only be able to help you come to a place in your heart where you can see what Christ did on the cross for you. He took the punishment for your sin. We all have sinned. Become a part of God's family by accepting these

truths God loves me, Christ died for me, I have sinned, if I trust that He shed His blood for me and receive His gift of salvation, I have everlasting life.

Once you understand this you will find the following to be true:

- Then you will abide (walk with) the Father and the Son (I John 2:24)
- His word will help you to overcome those who try to deceive you (I John 2:26)
- You or your child will know God’s teachings (anointings) are true and not a lie (I John 2:24)
- “And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart” (Deuteronomy 6:6)

You will discover a desire to know more about Him and His word, once you accept His gift of salvation. You’ll want to obey His commands and teach them diligently to your children and talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise as we read in Deuteronomy 6:7 (ESV).

The Apostle Paul said of Timothy that he had been taught the Holy Scriptures from childhood, and they

gave Timothy the wisdom to receive the salvation that comes by trusting in Christ Jesus, (II Tim. 3:15, NLT). He called Timothy a man of God.

Because our thoughts are where we battle against evil, you'll want your thoughts to be about God's Word and rule your behavior and it will if you are memorizing it.

These are just some of the results a child of God will experience as he or she grows in God's family. Loving the Word and wanting it as part of their life.

My son had just discovered there was a really rockin' youth group he wanted to attend. But t was about an hour from our country home. I used that desire as an incentive.

“If you can memorize your French vocabulary words perfectly by Friday, I'll drive you to that group even though it's so far. He got so enthused he memorized those French words and eventually became a leader in the youth group.

To become a leader, he was obligated to memorize quite a few verses. Today he does a lot of memorizations as a pastor. And he does very well.

There are those who either don't know they can memorize, don't want to, and some who truly have a difficult time because they don't have the right tools. There are some who have been mentally convinced they are not good at

something when once they consciously change their thinking are amazed at what they can do.

## 1. Our Coach Accountability Plan

## 2. Partial Parent Coaching Plan

We administer the training, parents may be present which will be helpful since you will do the practice sessions with your child. Parents can be in charge of practice sessions. Then we meet child online face to face for final recitation. Rules are below for earning the incentive gift.

## 3. Complete Parent Coaching Plan

You would simply invest in two more cheat sheets of eighteen black and white verses, (different ones than you received with this book, a spinning wheel for attaching verses (see image on page — and a booklet with memory tactics and mental tricks to help memorize any-thing from Bible verses to the Periodic Table of Elements.

The Complete Parent Coaching Plan can be a great bonding opportunity for families. But be sure to stick to the rules for best results.

### RULES: for all coaching plans

First comes the training session, learning how to memorize which is not the same class time for all students. Most six-year-olds on plans one and two will have 15-20 minutes of training. Trainings are online, either Facebook or Facetime with a KBM agent. We treat each student with respect to their individuality. During their **final recitation students**

**at age six** will be allowed one hesitation.

Students 7 to 12-years-old in plans one or two will have 25-30 minutes of training when the program begins.

**Practice sessions** will be available with a KBM agent online to practice our memory methods.

All students will decide when they are ready to have their **final recitation**, usually of one of two verses at a time. Therefore, all 7 to 12-year-old students will be expected to recite their verses without hesitancy, in other words, smoothly with confidence.

Final recitations will also be online with either Face Book Live or Face Time.

As you decide which plan is best for your family, consider what's going on around us in today's world. Kids need to see things according to spiritual views. We are currently swimming upstream in a society that continually flows in the opposite direction of God's truths. Help your family to paddle harder with the Word of God as their strength. Calm their anxieties as they memorize verses about God's wisdom, care, and control.

twelve-year-olds.

- \_\_\_\_\_ per practice sessions (all ages).
- \_\_\_\_\_ per final recitation of one or two verses.
